ADRP Review No. 107 – Ammonium nitrate exported from the Republic of China, Sweden and the Kingdom of Thailand

The reinvestigation report in relation to Anti-Dumping Review Panel (ADRP) Review No. 107 is currently due to the ADRP by 17 February 2020.

The Commission was provided with a timeframe of 90 days to conduct a reinvestigation of certain findings and report to you as required.

I request an extension of 50 days to 7 April 2020 to provide this report. I request this extension on the following grounds:

- the Commission has requested information and data from the Australian industry applicants for the post-investigation period. This information and data will be used to update the findings in relation to injury in the post-investigation period;
- to allow interested parties procedural fairness, I propose to publish a preliminary reinvestigation report and seek submissions. These submissions will then need to be considered before the reinvestigation report is finalised; and
- the Commission's high workload and the department shutdown over the Christmas and New Year period has had an impact on progress of the re-investigation.
