**ADRP Review No 2019/119 – Power Transformers exported from the Republic of Indonesia and Taiwan (case 504)**

The reinvestigation report in relation to Anti-Dumping Review Panel (ADRP) Review No. 2019/119 of power transformers is currently due to the ADRP by Tuesday, 31 March 2020. As you are aware, I was provided with a timeframe of 60 days to conduct a reinvestigation of certain findings and report to the ADRP as required.

I request an extension of 65 days (to Thursday, 4 June 2020), to provide my reinvestigation report to the ADRP. I request this extension on the following grounds:

- the issues raised in the reinvestigation request require the Anti-Dumping Commission (the Commission) to gather and analyse additional information from interested parties;
- some delays in the Commission's ability to gather this information is anticipated as a result of the COVID-19 pandemic, though the exact impact is unknown; and
- I propose to publish a preliminary reinvestigation report and will consider all submissions received within a reasonable timeframe in response, to provide interested parties with procedural fairness.
