Notice under section 269ZZI

Power Transformers exported from the Republic of Indonesia and Taiwan

The Anti-Dumping Review Panel (Review Panel) received applications from PT CG Power Systems Indonesia and Fortune Electric Co., Ltd seeking a review of a decision by the Minister for Industry, Science and Technology to publish a notice under section 269ZHG(1)(b) of the *Customs Act 1901* in respect of Power Transformers exported from the Republic of Indonesia and Taiwan (the Reviewable Decision).

The Reviewable Decision was published on the Anti-Dumping Commission (ADC) website on 6 November 2019 (ADN 2019/127).

The Review Panel is satisfied that the following grounds are reasonable grounds for the reviewable decision not being the correct or preferable decision:

Fortune Electric Co., Ltd

- (a) The ADC erred in calculating profit pursuant to section 45 of the Customs (International Obligations) Regulation 2015, which resulted in an overstated normal value;

PT CG Power Systems Indonesia

- (b) The evidence does not establish that dumping is likely to recur; and
- (c) It is not likely that material injury will recur.

The ADRP proposes to conduct a review of the Reviewable Decision in relation to the above grounds.

The goods to which these applications relate are:

Liquid dielectric power transformers with power ratings of equal to or greater than 10 MVA (mega volt amperes) and a voltage rating of less than 500kV (kilo volts) whether assembled or unassembled, complete or incomplete.

Submissions

Interested parties have **30 days** from the date this notice is published to provide the ADRP with a submission. Your submission should indicate your eligibility to make a submission as either an interested party to the Reviewable Decision or as one of the specified entities under section 269ZZJ of the Act.

If your submission contains confidential information, you must provide a public version that can be published on the ADRP website. Failure to do so will result in your submission not being considered.
