**ADRP Review No 2019/119 – Power Transformers exported from the Republic of Indonesia and Taiwan (case 504)**

The reinvestigation report in relation to Anti-Dumping Review Panel (ADRP) Review No. 2019/119 of power transformers is currently due to the ADRP by 4 June 2020.

I request a further extension of **35 days** (to Thursday, 9 July 2020), to provide my reinvestigation report. I request this extension because the issues raised in the reinvestigation request required the Anti-Dumping Commission (the Commission) to gather additional information from interested parties. It has taken longer than anticipated for the Commission to analyse this information and make its preliminary findings.

To provide all interested parties with procedural fairness, I intend to publish a preliminary reinvestigation report in early June and invite submissions in response. I will then consider all submissions received within a reasonable timeframe when preparing my final reinvestigation report.
