**ADRP Review Nos. 2019/120 and 2019/121
Hot Rolled Structural Sections exported from Japan, the Republic of Korea,
Taiwan (except for exports by Feng Hsin Steel Co Ltd)
and the Kingdom of Thailand (cases 499 and 505)**

The reinvestigation reports in relation to Anti-Dumping Review Panel (ADRP) Review Nos. 2019/120 and 2019/121 of hot rolled structural sections are currently due to the ADRP by Friday, 2 October 2020.

I request a further extension of 105 days (to Friday, 15 January 2021), to provide my reinvestigation reports to the ADRP. I request this extension on the following grounds:

- since publishing the preliminary reinvestigation report on 27 August 2020, submissions have been received raising issues which require further, detailed consideration;
- I propose to publish an addendum to the preliminary reinvestigation report to address the matters raised in submissions. I will then consider all submissions received within a reasonable timeframe in response, to provide interested parties with procedural fairness; and
- given the impending Christmas and New Year period and the fixed legislative timeframes of the ADRP to make a recommendation to the Minister following receipt of my reinvestigation report, I consider it preferable to provide you with my reinvestigation report in the new year.
