**ADRP Review No. 2020/126
Hollow Structural Sections exported from the Kingdom of Thailand (case 532)**

The reinvestigation report in relation to Anti-Dumping Review Panel (ADRP) Review No. 2020/126 of hollow structural sections is currently due to the ADRP by 29 January 2021.

I request an extension of 152 days (to 30 June 2021), to provide my reinvestigation report to the ADRP. I request this extension on the following grounds:

- the Commission has an ongoing high workload, including a number of continuation inquiries which must be my priority as they have a hard deadline (the measures will expire unless continued by the relevant date);
- I anticipate the completion of some cases in the near future, which will then allow me to allocate dedicated resources to this reinvestigation; and
- I propose to publish a preliminary reinvestigation report with my findings at an appropriate time in the reinvestigation process. I will then consider all submissions received within a reasonable timeframe in response, to provide interested parties with procedural fairness.
