ADRP Review No. 128 – A4 Copy Paper exported from the Republic of Indonesia by Pt Indah Kiat Pulp & Paper Tbk and Pt Pindo Deli Pulp and Paper Mills

Please be advised that the Anti-Dumping Review Panel (Review Panel) has initiated a review of the decision by the Minister for Industry, Science and Technology made under subsection 269ZDB(1)(a)(ii) of the *Customs Act 1901* in respect of A4 Copy Paper exported from the Republic of Indonesia by Pt Indah Kiat Pulp & Paper Tbk and Pt Pindo Deli Pulp and Paper Mills (the Reviewable Decision). An application for review of the Reviewable Decision was made by Paper Australia Pty Ltd. The review was initiated on 30 October 2020.

For the purpose of obtaining the relevant information in relation to this review, the Review Panel requests the Anti-Dumping Commission (ADC) provide the following documents:

1. Any confidential attachments to the Statement of Essential Facts (SEF) relevant to the grounds of the review application (assuming the SEF will otherwise be on the public record);
2. Any parties' submissions to the ADC commenting on the SEF, including confidential attachments relevant to the grounds of the application for review;

3. Any confidential attachments to the Final Report relating to Indah Kiat and Pindo Deli (assuming the full Final Report will otherwise be on the public record); and
4. Any other *relevant information* (as defined in s269ZZK *Customs Act 1901*) pertinent to the grounds of review raised by the Applicant.

Confidential and Public ADC Documents

Only confidential versions of documents need to be provided. Public versions of documents that have been published on the ADC's Electronic Public Record for the relevant case, are not required.
