**Extension of Time for the Anti-Dumping Review Panel to complete Review No. 128:
A4 Copy Paper exported from the Republic of Indonesia by Pt Indah Kiat Pulp &
Paper Tbk and Pt Pindo Deli Pulp and Paper Mills**

On 30 October 2020, the Anti-Dumping Review Panel (Review Panel) published, under subsection 269ZZI of the *Customs Act 1901* (the Act), a notice of its intention to conduct a review of the decision of the Minister for Industry, Science and Technology (the Minister) to declare under subsection 269ZDB(1)(a)(ii) of the Act that the dumping duty notice applying to A4 Copy Paper exported from the Republic of Indonesia by Pt Indah Kiat Pulp & Paper Tbk and Pt Pindo Deli Pulp and Paper Mills was taken to have been revoked (the Reviewable Decision).

Subsection 269ZZK(3) of the Act requires the Review Panel to provide its report to the Minister within 60 days after the public notification of the review under section 269ZZI, or such longer period allowed by the Minister in writing because of special circumstances.

On 12 December 2020, the Minister, pursuant to subsection 269ZZK(3)(b)(i) of the Act, has allowed a longer period for the Review Panel to provide its report to the Minister because of special circumstances.

The decision of the Review Panel is now due on or before **18 January 2021**.
