ADRP Review No. 131 – Hollow Structural Sections exported from the People's Republic of China, the Republic of Korea, Malaysia, Taiwan and the Kingdom of Thailand

Please be advised that the Anti-Dumping Review Panel (Review Panel) has initiated a review of the decision by the then Minister for Industry, Science and Technology made under subsection 269ZDB(1) of the *Customs Act 1901* in respect of Hollow Structural Sections exported from the People's Republic of China, the Republic of Korea, Malaysia, Taiwan and the Kingdom of Thailand (the Reviewable Decision). The review was initiated on 16 April 2021. An application for review of the Reviewable Decision was made by Orrcon Manufacturing Pty Ltd (Orrcon).

For the purpose of obtaining the relevant information in relation to this review, the Review Panel requests the Anti-Dumping Commission (ADC) provide the following documents:

 Any confidential attachments to the Statement of Essential Facts (SEF) relevant to Orrcon's grounds of the review as detailed in its application for review.

- Any member of the Australian industry's submissions to the ADC commenting on the SEF, including confidential attachments relevant to Orrcon's grounds of the application for review.
- 3. Any confidential attachments to the Final Report relating to material injury and to Orrcon's normal value, export price and dumping margin.
- 4. The Work Program relating to Kukje's on-site verification.
- 5. Kukje's purchases, by country of export, of imported HRC in the review period.
- 6. Any other *relevant information* (as defined in s269ZZK *Customs Act 1901*) pertinent to the grounds of review raised by Orrcon.
