**ADRP Review No. 133 – A4 Copy Paper exported from the People’s Republic of China:  
Anti-Circumvention Inquiry**

Please be advised that the Anti-Dumping Review Panel (Review Panel) has initiated a review of the decision by the then Minister for Industry, Science and Technology made under subsection 269ZDBH(1) of the *Customs Act 1901* in respect of A4 Copy Paper (the goods) exported from the People’s Republic of China: Anti-Circumvention Inquiry (the Reviewable Decision).
