Anti-Dumping Review Panel

**Extension of Time for the Anti-Dumping Review Panel to complete Review No. 133:
A4 Copy Paper exported from the People's Republic of China**

On 28 April 2021, the Anti-Dumping Review Panel (Review Panel) published, under subsection 269ZZI of the *Customs Act 1901* (the Act), a notice of its intention to conduct a review of the decision of the then Minister for Industry, Science and Technology (the Minister) made under subsection 269ZDBH(1) of the Act in respect of the dumping duty notice and countervailing duty notice applying to A4 Copy Paper exported from the People's Republic of China (the Reviewable Decision).

Unless the Review Panel requires a reinvestigation, subsection 269ZZK(3) of the Act provides that the Review Panel must provide its report to the Minister within 60 days after the public notification of the review under section 269ZZI, or such longer period allowed by the Minister in writing because of special circumstances.

Pursuant to subsection 269ZZK(3)(b)(i) of the Act, the Minister allowed a longer period for the Review Panel to provide its report to the Minister because of special circumstances. The Review Panel's recommendation was due to the Minister by **14 July 2021**.
