## Notice under section 269ZZI

## Ammonium Nitrate exported from the Russian Federation

The Anti-Dumping Review Panel (Review Panel) has received applications seeking a review of a decision by the Minister for Industry, Science and Technology (the Minister) to publish a notice under section 269ZHG(1) of the *Customs Act 1901* (the Act) in respect of ammonium nitrate exported from the Russian Federation (the Reviewable Decision). The applications were received from:

- CSBP Limited:
- Dyno Nobel Asia Pacific Pty Limited;
- Orica Australia Pty Ltd; and
- Queensland Nitrates Pty Ltd.

The Reviewable Decision was published on the Anti-Dumping Commission (ADC) website on 23 May 2021 (ADN 2021/53).

The grounds of review of the applicants are substantially the same. The Review Panel is satisfied that the following grounds are, in respect of each of the applicants, reasonable grounds for the Reviewable Decision not being the correct or preferable decision:

- (a) The Minister wrongly determined the dumping margin in respect of the goods and should have found that the expiration of the anti-dumping measures would have lead or would be likely to have lead to a continuation or recurrence of dumping in Australia;
- (b) The Minister erred in failing to find that it was highly probable that exports of the goods from the Russian Federation would be dumped at significant margins; and
- (c) The Minister should have been satisfied that the Australian Industry would incur or would be likely to incur a recurrence of material injury in the absence of the measures.

The Review Panel proposes to conduct a review of the Reviewable Decision in relation to the above grounds.

The goods to which these applications relate are:

ammonium nitrate, prilled, granular or in other solid form, with or without additives or coatings, in packages exceeding 10 kg

## Submissions

Interested parties have **30 days** from the date on which this notice is published to provide the Review Panel with a submission. Your submission should indicate your eligibility to make a submission as either an interested party to the Reviewable Decision or as one of the specified entities under section 269ZZJ of the Act.

If your submission contains confidential information, you must provide a public version that can be published on the Review Panel website. Failure to do so will result in your submission not being considered.
