**ADRP Review No 2020/134
Ammonium Nitrate exported from the Russian Federation (Case 565)**

I refer to your letter of 17 September 2021 requesting the reinvestigation of certain findings in *Anti-Dumping Commission Report No 565*.

In your letter you requested that I report my findings to you by 5 January 2022. I am seeking an extension of 113 days (i.e. until 28 April 2022) to complete my reinvestigation and report my findings. I seek this extension for the following reasons:

- Further analysis is required in regard to assessing the appropriateness of the deduction of the Russian export tax from the competitive price benchmark. I anticipate that some aspects of this analysis will not be completed until February 2022.
- I propose to invite submissions from interested parties and publish a preliminary reinvestigation report. Consequently, sufficient time is required to enable interested parties to make submissions to the reinvestigation and in response to the preliminary reinvestigation report.
