**Aluminium Extrusions (Mill Finish) exported from Malaysia and Aluminium
Extrusions (Surface Finished) exported from Malaysia**

The Anti-Dumping Review Panel (ADRP) has completed a review of two decisions made by the then Minister for Industry, Science and Technology (the then Minister) under subsections 269TG(1) and (2) of the *Customs Act 1901* (the Act) in respect of:

- Aluminium Extrusions (Mill Finish) exported from Malaysia (ADN 2021/033 refers); and
- Aluminium Extrusions (Surface Finished) exported from Malaysia (ADN 2021/035 refers) (the Reviewable Decisions).

The Reviewable Decisions were published on the Anti-Dumping Commission's website on 2 June 2021.

Criterion Industries Pty Ltd (Criterion) and Milleon Extruder Sdn. Bhd (Milleon) made applications to the ADRP for review of the then Minister's decision in ADN 2021/033. Criterion also made an application to the ADRP for review of the then Minister's decision in ADN 2021/035. A copy of the applications are available on the ADRP website at www.adreviewpanel.gov.au.

On 13 September 2021, the ADRP made its report to the then Minister (ADRP Report No. 135 & 137). A copy of the report is available on the ADRP website. Any confidential information contained in ADRP Report No. 135 & 137 has been removed from the version available on the ADRP website. If your confidential information forms part of ADRP Report No. 135 & 137, you can request a copy of the report containing your confidential information from the ADRP Secretariat via the details available on the ADRP website.

The ADRP has recommended that the Reviewable Decisions be **affirmed**. I, ANGUS TAYLOR, the Acting Minister for Industry, Science and Technology have considered and accepted the recommendations, and reasons for the recommendations, made by the ADRP in ADRP Report No. 135 & 137, including all material findings of fact or law as set out in ADRP Report No 135 & 137. Therefore, in accordance with section 269ZZM(1)(a) of the Act, I **affirm** the Reviewable Decisions. The Reviewable Decisions are to have effect from the date the Reviewable Decisions were set to take effect.

Applications for review of this decision under the *Administrative Decisions (Judicial Review) Act 1977* should be made to the Federal Court of Australia within 28 days of:

- The publication of this notice and ADRP Report No 135 & 137; or
- If the public version of the ADRP Report No 135 & 137 contains any redactions to remove your confidential information, such later date on which you receive a copy of ADRP Report No 135 & 137 without your confidential information redacted.
