Notice under section 269ZZM(1B)

**Consumer Pineapple exported from the Republic of the Philippines and the Kingdom of  
Thailand**

The Anti-Dumping Review Panel (ADRP) has completed a review of a decision which the former Acting Minister for Industry, Science and Technology made under subsection 269ZHG(1)(a) of the *Customs Act 1901* in respect of Consumer Pineapple exported from the Republic of the Philippines and the Kingdom of Thailand (the Reviewable Decision). The Reviewable Decision was published on the Anti-Dumping Commission (ADC) website on 6 October 2021 (ADN 2021/117).

On 15 July 2022, the ADRP made its report in accordance with section 269ZZK(3)(b)(ii) of the Act. Subsection 269ZZM(1A) of the Act requires that I make a decision within 30 days after receiving that report, unless I consider special circumstances prevent my decision being made within that period. If I do consider that such special circumstances exist, the decision may be made within such longer period as I consider appropriate.

My decision in relation to the ADRP's report is due by 15 August 2022. However, I am satisfied that there are special circumstances that prevent a decision under section 269ZZM(1) being made by 15 August 2022 and that it is appropriate to extend the time for making the decision.

Accordingly, I have decided under section 269ZZM(1A)(b) of the Act to extend the period for making my decision to 14 September, 2022.
