Direction under section 269ZYB(2)

Reconsideration of Power Transformers exported from the People's Republic of China (China) by ABB Chongqing Transformer Co Ltd (ABB Chongqing), Siemens Transformer (Jinan) Co Ltd (Siemens Jinan) and Siemens Transformer (Wuhan) Co Ltd (Siemens Wuhan)

On 11 April 2022, the Anti-Dumping Review Panel (Review Panel) published notice that it had recommenced its review of the decisions of the Anti-Dumping Commissioner made under section 269TDA(1) of the *Customs Act 1901* (the Act) to terminate Investigation 507 in respect of Power Transformers exported from China by ABB Chongqing, Siemens Jinan and Siemens Wuhan (the Reviewable Decision).

On 4 March 2020, I had directed under section 269ZYA of the Act that the Review Panel for the review of the Reviewable Decision be constituted by Review Panel Member, Scott Ellis. From 3 May 2022, Scott Ellis ceased to be a member of the Review Panel.

Pursuant to s.269ZYB(2) of the Act, I direct that the Review Panel for the review of the Reviewable Decision be constituted by Jaclyne Fisher.
