ADRP Review No. 151 – Aluminium Zinc Coated Steel of a width equal to or greater than 600 millimetres exported from the Republic of Korea, Taiwan and the Socialist Republic of Vietnam

Please be advised that the Anti-Dumping Review Panel (Review Panel) has initiated a review of the decision by the Minister for Industry, Energy and Emissions Reduction, made under subsection 269TG(1) and (2) of the *Customs Act 1901*, in respect of Aluminium Zinc Coated Steel of a width equal to or greater than 600 millimetres exported from the Republic of Korea and the Socialist Republic of Vietnam (the Reviewable Decision). The review was initiated on 31 January 2022. Applications for review of the Reviewable Decision were made by Hoa Sen Group Joint Stock Company (HSG) and Macsteel International Australia (Macsteel).

For the purpose of obtaining the relevant information in relation to this review, the Review Panel requests the Anti-Dumping Commission (ADC) provide the following documents:

1. Any confidential attachments to the Statement of Essential Facts (SEF) relevant to the grounds of the review applications (assuming the SEF will otherwise be on the public record)

2. Any parties' submissions to the ADC commenting on the SEF, including confidential attachments relevant to the grounds of the applications for review.
3. Any confidential attachments to the Final Report (assuming the full Final Report will otherwise be on the public record)
4. Any other *relevant information* (as defined in s269ZZK *Customs Act 1901*) pertinent to the grounds of review raised by the applicants, for example:
 - If the grounds relate to normal value, please provide the relevant exporter visit reports, plus any confidential information/spreadsheets sent to the exporter regarding the calculation of the normal value, export price and dumping margins.
 - If grounds relate to unsuppressed selling price/non-injurious price please provide the verification visit report of the Australian industry and any confidential attachments or the confidential information used to determine the non-injurious price.
 - If grounds relate to material injury/causal link please provide the verification visit report of the Australian industry and any confidential attachments.
5. Any other records/documents that contain information about the verification report/s or the model matching for the purposes of the normal value assessment.
