Notice under section 269ZZM(4)

**Aluminium Zinc Coated Steel of a width equal to or greater than 600 millimetres  
exported from the Republic of Korea, Taiwan and Socialist Republic of Vietnam**

The Anti-Dumping Review Panel (ADRP) has completed a review of a decision which I, ANGUS TAYLOR, Minister for Industry, Energy and Emissions Reduction made under subsections 269TG(1) and (2) of the *Customs Act 1901* in respect of Aluminium Zinc Coated Steel of a width equal to or greater than 600 millimetres exported from the Republic of Korea and Socialist Republic of Vietnam (the Reviewable Decision).<sup>1</sup> The Reviewable Decision was published on the Anti-Dumping Commission (ADC) website on 24 December 2021 (ADN 2021/147).

Applications for review of the Reviewable Decision were made by Hoa Sen Group Joint Stock Company and Macsteel International Australia. A copy of the applications are available on the ADRP website at [www.adreviewpanel.gov.au](http://www.adreviewpanel.gov.au).

On 1 April 2022, the ADRP made its report to me (ADRP Report No. 151). A copy of this report is available on the ADRP website. Any confidential information contained in ADRP Report No. 151 has been removed from the version available on the ADRP website. The ADRP has recommended that the Reviewable Decision be **affirmed**.

I, ANGUS TAYLOR, Minister for Industry, Energy and Emissions Reduction have considered and accepted the recommendations, and reasons for the recommendations, made by the ADRP in ADRP Report No. 151 including all material findings of fact or law as set out in ADRP Report No. 151.

Therefore, in accordance with section 269ZZM(1)(a) of the *Customs Act 1901*, I **affirm** the Reviewable Decision. The Reviewable Decision is to have effect from the date the Reviewable Decision was set to take effect.

Applications for review of this decision under the *Administrative Decisions (Judicial Review) Act 1977* should be made to the Federal Court of Australia within 28 days of:

- The publication of this notice and ADRP Report No. 151; or
- If the public version of the ADRP Report No. 151 contains any redactions to remove your confidential information, such later date on which you receive a copy of ADRP Report No. 151 without your confidential information redacted.
