**ADRP Review No. 153 – A4 copy paper exported from the Federative Republic of Brazil, the People’s Republic of China, the Republic of Indonesia and the Kingdom of Thailand**

Please be advised that the Anti-Dumping Review Panel (Review Panel) has initiated a review of the decision by the Minister for Industry, Energy and Emissions Reduction, made under subsection 269ZHG(1)(b) of the *Customs Act 1901*, in respect of A4 copy paper exported from the Federative Republic of Brazil (Brazil), the People’s Republic of China (China), the Republic of Indonesia (Indonesia) and the Kingdom of Thailand (Thailand) (the Reviewable Decision). The review was initiated on 24 May 2022. Applications for review of the Reviewable Decision were made by:

- APRIL Far East (Malaysia) Sdn. Bhd and PT Riau Andalan Kertas, collectively known as (APRIL);
- Sylvamo do Brasil Ltda;and
- UPM Asia Pacific Pte Ltd.

For the purpose of obtaining the relevant information in relation to this review, the Review Panel requests the Anti-Dumping Commission (ADC) provide the following documents:

1. Any confidential attachments to the Final Report (REP 588)
2. Any other *relevant information* (as defined in s269ZZK *Customs Act 1901*) pertinent to the grounds of review raised by the Applicants, for example:

- If grounds relate to material injury/causal link please provide the verification visit report of the Australian industry and any confidential attachments.
- In reference to APRIL's exports, details of the normal value determination including adjustments.
