# ADRP Review No. 154 – Clear float glass exported from Malaysia and the United Arab Emirates

Please be advised that the Anti-Dumping Review Panel (Review Panel) has initiated a review of the decision by the Commissioner of the Anti-Dumping Commission, made under subsection 269TDA(13) of the *Customs Act 1901*, in respect of clear float glass exported from the United Arab Emirates (UAE) (the Reviewable Decision). The review was initiated on 29 July 2022. An application for review of the Reviewable Decision was made by Oceania Glass Pty Ltd (Oceania).

For the purpose of obtaining information in relation to this review – being the information which was before the Commissioner when the Commissioner made the Reviewable Decision, the Review Panel requests the Anti-Dumping Commission (ADC) provide the following documents:

    the verification visit report of the Australian industry and any confidential
    attachments or the confidential information used to determine the non-injurious
    price;
  - If the grounds relate to normal value, please provide the relevant exporter visit reports, plus any confidential information/spreadsheets sent to the exporter regarding the calculation of the normal value, export price and dumping margins.
  - If the grounds relate to export price please provide the exporter and importer visit reports and any confidential information/spreadsheets sent to the exporter and/or importer regarding dumping margins.
- 5. Any other records/documents that contain information about the verification report/s or the model matching for the purposes of the normal value assessment.

Only confidential versions of documents need to be provided. Public versions of documents that have been published on the ADC's Electronic Public Record for the relevant case, are not required.
