Clear Float Glass exported from Malaysia and the United Arab Emirates

The Anti-Dumping Review Panel (Review Panel) received an application from Oceania Glass Pty Ltd (Oceania) seeking a review of a decision by the Commissioner of the Anti-Dumping Commission (ADC) to terminate the investigation under subsection 269TDA(13) of the *Customs Act 1901* in respect of clear float glass (CFG) exported from the United Arab Emirates (UAE) (the Reviewable Decision).

The Reviewable Decision was published on the Anti-Dumping Commission (ADC) website on 23 June 2022 (ADN 2022/059).

The Review Panel is satisfied that the following ground is a reasonable ground for the Reviewable Decision not being the correct or preferable decision:

Oceania Glass Pty Ltd

- 1) The Commissioner's decision that he is not satisfied that there is a causal link between dumped exports of the goods from the UAE and Australian industry's economic position is not the correct or preferable decision.

The Review Panel proposes to conduct a review of the Reviewable Decision in relation to the above ground.

The goods to which these applications relate are:

CFG (clear float glass) in nominal thicknesses of 3 to 12 millimeters (mm).
