Hot Rolled Coil Steel exported from Taiwan

The Anti-Dumping Review Panel (Review Panel) has completed a review of my decision made under subsection 269ZHG(1)(b) of the *Customs Act 1901* in respect of Hot Rolled Coil Steel exported to Australia from Taiwan (the Reviewable Decision). The Reviewable Decision was published on the Anti-Dumping Commission (ADC) website on 25 November 2022 (ADN 2022/109).

An application for review of the Reviewable Decision was made by China Steel Corporation. A copy of the application is available on the Review Panel website at www.adreviewpanel.gov.au.

On 20 March 2023, the Review Panel made its report to me (Report No. 165). A copy of this report is available on the Review Panel website. The Review Panel has recommended that the Reviewable Decision be **affirmed**.

I, ED HUSIC, Minister for Industry and Science have considered and accepted the recommendations, and reasons for the recommendations, made by the Review Panel in Report No. 165, including all material findings of fact or law as set out in Report No. 165.

Therefore, in accordance with section 269ZZM(1)(a) of the *Customs Act 1901*, I **affirm** the Reviewable Decision. The Reviewable Decision is to have effect from the date the Reviewable Decision was set to take effect.

Applications for review of this decision under the *Administrative Decisions (Judicial Review) Act 1977* should be made to the Federal Court of Australia within 28 days of:

- The publication of this notice and Report No 165; or
- If the public version of the Report No 165 contains any redactions to remove your confidential information, such later date on which you receive a copy of Report No 165 without your confidential information redacted.
