Notice under section 269ZZI

Hot Rolled Coil Steel exported from Taiwan

The Anti-Dumping Review Panel (Review Panel) received an application from the China Steel Corporation seeking a review of a decision by the Minister for Industry and Science under section 269ZHG(1) of the *Customs Act 1901* to secure the continuation of the anti-dumping measures applying to Hot Rolled Coil Steel exported from Taiwan (the Reviewable Decision).

The Reviewable Decision was published on the Anti-Dumping Commission (ADC) website on 25 November 2022 (ADN 2022/109).

The Review Panel is satisfied that the following ground is a reasonable ground for the Reviewable Decision not being the correct or preferable decision:

1. The Minister erred in finding that recurrence of material injury was likely in the absence of measures.

The Review Panel proposes to conduct a review of the Reviewable Decision in relation to the above ground.

The goods to which the application relates are:

Hot rolled coil (including in sheet form), a flat rolled product of iron or non-alloy steel, not clad, plated or coated (other than oil coated). Goods excluded from this application are hot rolled products that have patterns in relief (known as checker plate) and plate products.

The goods do not include hot rolled sheet that is 4.75mm (3/16th of an inch) thick or more as it is considered to be plate. HRC in coil form with a thickness of 4.75mm or more is still subject to the measures.

Submissions

Interested parties have **30 days** from the date on which this notice is published to provide the Review Panel with a submission. Your submission should indicate your eligibility to make a submission as either an interested party to the Reviewable Decision or as one of the specified entities under section 269ZZJ of the Act.

If your submission contains confidential information, you must provide a public version that can be published on the Review Panel website. Failure to do so will result in your submission not being considered.
