Notice under section 269ZZI

Interchangeable bolted clipping system clip heads exported from the People's Republic of China

The Anti-Dumping Review Panel ('Review Panel') received an application from AC Plumbing Supplies Pty Ltd seeking a review of the Minister for Industry and Innovation and Minister for Science's decision under sections 269TG(1) and (2) of the *Customs Act 1901* ('the Act') in respect of interchangeable bolted clipping system clip heads exported from the People's Republic of China ('the Reviewable Decision').

The Reviewable Decision was published on the Anti-Dumping Commission ('ADC') website on 2 October 2025 (ADN 2025/090 refers).

The Review Panel is satisfied that the following grounds are reasonable grounds for the Reviewable Decision not being the correct or preferable decision:

- 1) Ground 1 Incorrect reliance on s 269TAC(6) to determine the normal value
- 2) Ground 2 Normal values not in "ordinary course of trade"
- 3) Ground 3 Erroneous determination of material injury, based on the following factors:
 - a) Price undercutting.
 - b) Market size and composition;
 - c) Loss of sales volumes to mutual customers;
 - d) Profit effects; and
 - e) The size of the dumping margins.

The Review Panel proposes to conduct a review of the Reviewable Decision in relation to the above grounds.

The goods to which the application relates are:

Interchangeable bolted clipping system clip-heads, with galvanized or powder coating finish, in the size range 12 to 150 mm (i.e. 0.5 inch to 6 inch) diameter, with elongated emboss and square hole for interlocking coach bolt and nut.

Supporting physical appearance information:

This interchangeable bolted clipping system also ensures the linear alignment of the clip head with the bracket, not allowing for any movement when installed.

The interchangeable bolted clipping system clip-heads are manufactured from galvanised hot rolled coil (HRC). The grade of galvanised HRC is Z275 grade and is of varying thicknesses of 1mm to 2 mm, dependent upon model of clip-head.

Submissions

Interested parties have **30 days** after the date on which this notice is published to provide the Review Panel with a submission. Your submission should indicate your eligibility to make a submission as either an interested party to the Reviewable Decision or as one of the specified entities under section 269ZZJ of the Act.

If your submission contains confidential information, you must provide a public version that can be published on the Review Panel website. Failure to do so will result in your submission not being considered. All information that is confidential or commercially sensitive must be highlighted in yellow in the confidential version of your submission.
