**Review No. 176 - Hot rolled deformed steel reinforcing bar in lengths exported from Indonesia, Malaysia, Thailand, Türkiye and Vietnam**

The Anti-Dumping Review Panel (Review Panel) has today initiated a review of the decision by the Minister for Industry and Innovation to publish a dumping duty notice under sections 269TG(1) and (2) of the *Customs Act 1901* in respect of hot rolled deformed steel reinforcing bar in lengths (the goods) from Indonesia, Malaysia, Thailand, Türkiye and Vietnam (the Reviewable Decision). Applications for review of the Reviewable Decision were made by:

- Alliance Steel (M) Sdn Bhd (Alliance)
- Malaysia Steel Works (KL) Bhd (Masteel)
- VAS Group Nghi Son Joint Stock Company (VAS)

For the purpose of obtaining the relevant information in relation to this review, the Review Panel requests the Anti-Dumping Commission (ADC) provide the following documents:

## PUBLIC

1. Any confidential attachments to the Statement of Essential Facts (SEF) relevant to the grounds of the review applications (assuming the SEF will otherwise be on the public record)
2. Any parties' submissions to the ADC commenting on the SEF, including confidential attachments relevant to the grounds of the applications for review
3. Any confidential attachments to the Final Report (assuming the full Final Report will otherwise be on the public record) relevant to the grounds of review
4. Any other *relevant information* (as defined in s 269ZZK of the *Customs Act 1901*) pertinent to the grounds of review raised by the Applicants, for example:
  - If grounds relate to unsuppressed selling price/non-injurious price, please provide the verification visit report of the Australian industry and any confidential attachments or the confidential information used to determine the non-injurious price
  - If the grounds relate to normal value, please provide the relevant exporter visit reports, plus any confidential information/spreadsheets sent to the exporter regarding the calculation of the normal value, export price and dumping margins.
  - If the grounds relate to export price, please provide the exporter and importer visit reports and any confidential information/spreadsheets sent to the exporter and/or importer regarding dumping margins
  - If the grounds relate to subsidy levels, please provide any confidential information/spreadsheets sent to the relevant exporter regarding the calculation of subsidy and countervailing margins. A copy of information about the subsidy (i.e. any documents establishing the terms of and eligibility for the subsidy) should be provided
  - If grounds relate to material injury/causal link please provide the verification visit report of the Australian industry and any confidential attachments.
5. Any other records/documents that contain information about the verification report/s or the model matching for the purposes of the normal value assessment.


Only confidential versions of documents are required. Public versions of documents that are available on the ADC's Electronic Public Record are not required.
