**ADRP Review No 177 – Tomatoes, prepared or preserved exported from the Italian Republic**

The Anti-Dumping Review Panel ('Review Panel') has today initiated a review of the Minister for Industry and Innovation and Minister for Science's decision under section 269TL(1) of the *Customs Act 1901* ('the Act') in respect of prepared or preserved tomatoes exported from the Italian Republic ('the Reviewable Decision'). An application for review of the Reviewable Decision was made by SPC Operations Pty Ltd ('SPC').

For the purpose of obtaining the relevant information in relation to this review, the Review Panel requests the Anti-Dumping Commission ('ADC') provide the following documents:

1. Any confidential attachments to the Statement of Essential Facts 654 ('SEF 654') relevant to the grounds of the review application (assuming the SEF 654 will otherwise be on the public record)
2. Any parties' submissions to the ADC commenting on the SEF 654, including confidential attachments relevant to the grounds of the application for review.

3. Any confidential attachments to the ADC's Final Report 654 relevant to the grounds of the review application (assuming the full Final Report will otherwise be on the public record)
4. Any other *relevant information* (as defined in s 269ZZK of the Act) pertinent to the grounds of review raised by the Applicant, for example:
  - please provide the verification visit report of the Australian industry and any confidential attachments regarding material injury and causal link as well as any other records/documents that contain information about the Australian industry verification report.
  - Please provide any other records/documents that contain information about material injury and causation including relating to any factors other than dumping causing material injury.

### **Confidential Application**

### **Confidential and Public ADC Documents**

Only confidential versions of documents are required. Public versions of documents that are available on the ADC's Electronic Public Record are not required.
