Press Metal Aluminium (Australia) Pty Ltd (PMAA) – Review 175 - Aluminium Extrusions exported from the People’s Republic of China

I refer to your letter dated 23 January 2026 on behalf of your client, Press Metal Aluminium (Australia) Pty Ltd (PMAA) in relation to the above-mentioned review being conducted by the Anti-Dumping Review Panel (Review Panel).

The Review Panel, pursuant to s 269ZZL of the *Customs Act 1901* (the Act), required the Commissioner of the Anti-Dumping Commission (ADC) to conduct a reinvestigation of a certain finding that formed the basis of the reviewable decision. This letter was sent on 19 January 2026.

A copy of the reinvestigation letter has been placed on the Review Panel’s website. It is noted that the time in which the Review Panel may require a reinvestigation has now expired. Accordingly, your request that a reinvestigation be conducted in relation to another finding relating to the reviewable decision is not within the powers available to the Review Panel.

The time frame in which submissions to the Review Panel could be made, pursuant to s 269ZZJ of the Act, were required within 30 days of the initiation of this review. In this

matter, submissions closed on 22 December 2025. In this regard your letter does not constitute a submission to the Review Panel.
