**Interchangeable Bolted Clipping System Brackets exported from the People's Republic of China**

The Anti-Dumping Review Panel (Panel) has completed a review of my decision made under subsections 269TG(1) and (2) of the *Customs Act 1901* (the Act) in relation to interchangeable bolted clipping system brackets exported from the People's Republic of China (the Reviewable Decision). The Reviewable Decision was published on the Anti-Dumping Commission (ADC) website on 2 October 2025 (ADN 2025/089).

An application for review of the Reviewable Decision was made by AC Plumbing Supplies Pty Ltd. A copy of the application is available on the Panel website at [www.industry.gov.au/trade/anti-dumping-review-panel](http://www.industry.gov.au/trade/anti-dumping-review-panel).

On 10 March 2026, the Panel made its report to me (Report No. 173). A public version of Report No. 173 is available on the Panel's website, with confidential information removed. Where confidential information of a party has been redacted, that party may request a copy of the report containing its confidential information from the Panel Secretariat using the contact details on the Panel's website.

In Report No. 173, the Panel recommended that the Reviewable Decision be revoked and substituted with a new decision to:

- determine a revised normal value for Ningbo Fenghui Metal Products Co., Ltd (Fenghui); and
- vary ADN 2025/089 to reduce Fenghui's dumping margin from 71.2% to 63.8%.

I, Senator the Hon Tim Ayres, Minister for Industry and Innovation and Minister for Science have considered and accepted the Panel's recommendations and the reasons for those recommendations, including the Panel's material findings of fact and law as set out in Report No. 173.

Therefore, in accordance with section 269ZZM(1)(b) of the Act, I **revoke** the Reviewable Decision and **substitute** a new decision as recommended by the Panel. The substituted decision is to have effect from the date on which the Reviewable Decision originally took effect.

Applications for review of this decision under the *Administrative Decisions (Judicial Review) Act 1977* should be made to the Federal Court of Australia within 28 days of:

- The publication of this notice and Report No. 173; or
- Where the public version of Report No. 173 contains redactions to remove your confidential information, such later date on which you receive a copy of Report No. 173 without your confidential information redacted.
