Notice under section 269ZZM(4)

Aluminium Extrusions exported from the People's Republic of China

The Anti-Dumping Review Panel (Panel) has completed a review of my earlier decision under subsection 269ZH(1)(b) of the *Customs Act 1901* (the Act) in respect of aluminium extrusions (the goods) exported from the People's Republic of China (China) (the Reviewable Decision). The Reviewable Decision was published on the Anti-Dumping Commission (ADC) website on 17 October 2025 (ADN 2025/096).

Applications for review of the Reviewable Decision were made by:

- Goomax Metal Co., Ltd (Goomax)
- Guangdong Xingfa Aluminium Co Ltd (Xingfa)
- Press Metal Aluminium (Australia) Pty Ltd (PMAA)

On 20 April 2026, the Panel made its report to me (Report No 175). A public version of Report No 175 is available on the Panel's website, with confidential information removed. Where confidential information of a party has been redacted, that party may request a copy of the report containing its confidential information from the Panel Secretariat using the contact details on the Panel's website.

The Panel has recommended that the Reviewable Decision be revoked and be substituted with a new decision to:

- Continue the anti-dumping measures applying to the goods exported from China by Goomax, but with a different variable factors fixed resulting in a new subsidy margin and effective rate of duty of 0.9 per cent.
- Continue the anti-dumping measures applying to the goods exported from China by all other exporters with the variable factors fixed as specified in Anti-Dumping Notice 2025/096.

I, Senator the Hon Tim Ayres, Minister for Industry and Innovation and Minister for Science have considered and accepted the recommendations, and reasons for the recommendations, made by the Panel in Report No 175, including all material findings of fact or law as set out in Report No 175.

Therefore, in accordance with section 269ZZM(1)(b) of the Act, I **revoke** the Reviewable Decision and **substitute** a new decision as recommended by the Panel. The new decision is to have effect from the date the Reviewable Decision was specified to take effect in ADN 2025/096, being 29 October 2025.

Applications for review of this decision under the *Administrative Decisions (Judicial Review) Act 1977* should be made to the Federal Court of Australia within 28 days of:

- The publication of this notice and Report No 175; or
- If the public version of Report No 175 contains any redactions to remove your confidential information, such later date on which you receive a copy of Report No 175 with your confidential information unredacted.
