ADRP Review No. 182 – Hollow Structural Sections exported to Australia from the People's Republic of China, the Republic of Korea, Malaysia and Taiwan

The Anti-Dumping Review Panel (Review Panel) has today initiated a review of the decision by the Minister for Industry and Innovation and Minister for Science, made under subsection 269ZDBH(1) of the *Customs Act 1901*, in respect of Hollow Structural Sections exported from the People's Republic of China, the Republic of Korea, Malaysia and Taiwan (the Reviewable Decision). Applications for review of the Reviewable Decision were made by:

- Nextpower Australia Pty Ltd; and
- Gransolar Construction Australia Pty Ltd.

For the purpose of obtaining the relevant information in relation to this review, the Review Panel requests the Anti-Dumping Commission (ADC) provide the following documents:

1. Any confidential attachments to the Statement of Essential Facts (SEF 685) relevant to the grounds of the review application (assuming the SEF 685 will otherwise be on the public record).
2. Any parties' submissions to the ADC commenting on the SEF 685, including confidential attachments relevant to the grounds of the applications for review.

3. Any confidential attachments to the Final Report 685 (assuming the full Final Report 685 will otherwise be on the public record) relevant to the grounds of the applications for review.
4. Any other *relevant information* (as defined in s 269ZZK *Customs Act 1901*) pertinent to the grounds of review raised by the Applicants.
5. Any other records/documents that contain information about the verification or other visits to the premises of the Australian industry.
