**ADRP Review No.144 - Consumer Pineapple exported from the Republic of the Philippines and the Kingdom of Thailand**

I refer to your letter of 12 January 2022 requesting the reinvestigation of certain findings in *Anti-Dumping Commission Report No 571 and 572*.

In your letter you requested that I report my findings to you by 12 April 2022. I am seeking an extension of 63 days until 14 June 2022 to complete my reinvestigation and report my findings. I seek this extension for the following reasons:

- Further time is required to progress the reinvestigation and for me to report my findings. This includes further time for the commission to consider the complexities of the case, including further analysis on the relevant data.
- I propose to publish a preliminary reinvestigation report and invite submissions from interested parties, which will require additional time.
