**ADRP Review No 156 – Hollow Structural Sections exported from the People’s
Republic of China, the Republic of Korea, Malaysia and Taiwan
(Continuation Inquiry 590)**

I refer to your letter of 31 October 2022 requesting the reinvestigation of certain findings in *Anti-Dumping Commission Report No 590*.

In your letter you requested that I report my findings to you by 23 February 2023. I am seeking an extension of 71 days until 5 May 2023 to complete my reinvestigation and report my findings. I seek this extension because the Anti-Dumping Commission (commission) needs further time to:

- complete the examination of evidence and analysis as requested in the reinvestigation request, including a further examination of export and domestic pricing, as well as hot rolled coil pricing
- consider any possible impacts the analysis and finding may have on the likelihood of dumping and material injury (if the finding in relation to date of sale is changed).
