WIND TOWERS EXPORTED FROM THE PEOPLE'S REPUBLIC OF CHINA AND THE REPUBLIC OF KOREA – Invitation for Comment

The Anti-Dumping Review Panel (ADRP) received and accepted applications by:

- Win&P., Ltd; and
- Senvion Australia Pty Ltd & Senvion Systems SE (collectively Senvion)

Both seeking review of a decision of the Parliamentary Secretary to the Minister for Industry to: Publish a Dumping Duty Notice in relation to Wind Towers exported from the People's Republic of China and the Republic of Korea.

The Reviewable Decision was published on 16 April 2014.

- 4. If it seems appropriate, any additional background information in relation to the matter, including referring to any relevant policy position or guidelines which impacted on the decision under review.

It would be of assistance if the ADC could provide photographs and technical drawings (if you have them) illustrating what might constitute a wind tower and embed and the physical relationship between them.
