Review Application by BlueScope – Subsidisation of Hot Rolled Steel from China – Section 269ZZL(1) request

I refer to your letter of 21 March 2014 requesting the assistance of the Anti-Dumping Commission (the Commission), to reinvestigate whether the use of the import price of coking coal to China may provide a more appropriate benchmark in the determination of the adequate remuneration.

The date of 22 April 2014 has been set as the completion date for the reinvestigation for the purpose of section 269ZZL (2).

For a number of reasons, including an increased number of applications, the Commission is unlikely to be in a position to provide a considered report on the reinvestigation within the specified period. Accordingly, I respectfully request an extension of two and half weeks to the specified period, bringing the due for the report to 9 May.
