**STEEL REINFORCING BAR
Exported from Republic of Korea, Singapore, Spain and Taiwan**

The Anti-Dumping Review Panel (ADRP) has completed a review of my previous decision to declare by public notice that section 8 of the *Customs Tariff (Anti-Dumping) Act 1975* applies in respect to Steel Reinforcing Bar exported from the Republic of Korea, Singapore, Spain and Taiwan. The Reviewable Decision was made on the 11th November 2015 and published on 19 November 2015. An application for review of the Reviewable Decision was made by OneSteel Manufacturing Pty Ltd, Nervacero S.A and Best Bar Pty Ltd (Applications). Copies of the Applications are published on the ADRP website.

I, KAREN LESLEY ANDREWS, Assistant Minister for Science and Parliamentary Secretary to the Minister for Industry, Innovation and Science, have considered the recommendations and reasons for the recommendations made by the reviewing member of the ADRP, including all material findings of fact or law as set out in the ADRP report 34 dated 4 March 2016. I have decided to accept the recommendation made in ADRP report 34. In making my decision I have adopted the reasons set out in the ADRP report 34.

In accordance with section 269ZZM of the *Customs Act 1901* I have decided to revoke the Reviewable Decision with effect from 11 November 2015 and substitute another decision to publish a dumping duty notice in the same terms as that made on 11 November 2015 but amended to exclude from the notice exports of rebar from Spain by Nervacero S.A.
