Notice under section 269ZZM(4)

Zinc Coated (Galvanised) Steel Exported from the Republic of India, Malaysia and the Socialist Republic of Vietnam

The Anti-Dumping Review Panel (ADRP) has completed a review of a decision by the former Parliamentary Secretary to publish a notice under subsections 269TG(1) and (2), and 269TJ(1) and (2) in respect of Zinc Coated (Galvanised) Steel Exported from the Republic of India, Malaysia and the Socialist Republic of Vietnam (the Reviewable Decision). The Reviewable Decision was published on the Anti-Dumping Commission (ADC) website on 16 August 2017 (ADN 2017/99).

An application for review was received from BlueScope Steel Limited, who sought review of the Minister's decision in relation to exporter Essar Steel India Ltd. A copy of the application and the ADRP's report to me (ADRP Report No 67) is available on the ADRP website www.adreviewpanel.gov.au.

The ADRP has recommended that I affirm the Reviewable Decision.

I, ZED SESELJA, Parliamentary Secretary to the Minister for Jobs and Innovation, have considered and accepted the recommendations, and reasons for the recommendations, made by the ADRP in ADRP Report No 67, including all material findings of fact or law as set out in ADRP Report No 67.

Therefore, in accordance with section 269ZZM(1)(a) of the *Customs Act 1901* I **affirm** the reviewable decision.

Interested parties may seek a review of this decision by lodging an application with the Federal Court of Australia, in accordance with the requirements in the *Administrative Decisions (Judicial Review) Act 1977*, within 28 days of the publication of this notice.
