**CERTAIN ALUMINIUM EXTRUSIONS EXPORTED FROM THE PEOPLE'S
REPUBLIC OF CHINA – INVITATION TO COMMENT**

As you are aware, the Anti-Dumping Review Panel (ADRP) received applications from the following:

- **CAPRAL LIMITED** on 23 March 2015
- **PANASIA ALUMINIUM (CHINA) LIMITED** on 23 March 2015, and
- **OPAL (MACAO OFFSHORE COMMERCIAL)** on 23 March 2015,

seeking review of a decision by the Minister for Industry and Science to vary a Dumping Duty Notice and a Countervailing Duty Notice, in relation to CERTAIN ALUMINIUM EXTRUSIONS exported from THE PEOPLE'S REPUBLIC OF CHINA (the Reviewable Decision).

The Reviewable Decision was published on **19 February 2015**.

The report relevant to the applications for review is **Report No. 241**.

Please find attached the electronic copy of the applications.

The ADRP invites the Anti-Dumping Commission (the Commission) to comment on the applications. These comments will assist the ADRP's consideration of the claims made in the applications. It would be of assistance to the ADRP's initial consideration of the applications if the comments would please address the following, as relevant:

1. Identify any information provided with, or referred to in, the application, that, in the view of the Commission, is not *relevant information* as defined in s.269ZZK(6) *Customs Act 1901*;
2. Identify any factual claims in the application that the Commission disputes, and refer to *relevant information* in that regard;
3. Provide some commentary on the grounds of the application, referring to *relevant information*; and


4. If it seems appropriate, any additional background information in relation to the matter, including referring to any relevant policy position or guidelines which impacted on the decision under review.

Please note that the invitation and the response will be placed on the public file. To that end, the Commission is requested to supply a confidential and non-confidential copy of the comments.

As the time for submissions by interested parties expires on 11 May, 2015, the Commission is also requested to provide any comment by that time. If it is not possible to provide any comments on the applications before the deadline for submissions, then you should limit your comments to identifying information in the applications which is not "relevant information", and identifying information in Report 241 and its attachments which the Commission considers responsive to the applications.
