HOT ROLLED PLATE STEEL
Exported from the Republic of Korea

The Anti-Dumping Review Panel (ADRP) has completed a review of a decision by the Minister for Industry (The Minister) to impose dumping duties with respect to hot rolled plate steel exported from the Republic of Korea. The Minister's decision was published in the Australian on 19 December 2013.

Applications for review were made by Dongkuk Steel Mill Co. Ltd and GS Global Corporation. A copy of the applications and the ADRP Report to me is available on the ADRP website www.adreviewpanel.gov.au

The ADRP has recommended that I affirm the reviewable decision.
