CERTAIN DEEP DRAWN STAINLESS STEEL SINKS exported from the PEOPLE'S REPUBLIC OF CHINA

The Anti-Dumping Review Panel (ADRP) has received an application from Milena Australia Pty Ltd (Milena) seeking a review of a decision by the Assistant Minister for Industry, Innovation and Science and Parliamentary Secretary to the Minister for Industry, Innovation and Science (Parliamentary Secretary) following a review of anti-dumping measures to vary a dumping duty notice and countervailing duty notice (the reviewable decision), under subsection 269ZDB(1)(a)(iii) of the *Customs Act 1901* (the Act) in respect of CERTAIN DEEP DRAWN STAINLESS STEEL SINKS exported from the People's Republic of China (China).

The reviewable decision of the Parliamentary Secretary was published on the Anti-Dumping Commission (ADC) website on 21 November 2016.

The ADRP has accepted the following grounds raised in Milena's application:

- i. the construction of the normal value under subsection 269TAC(2)(c) of the Act is erroneous;
- ii. the decision that the cost of grade 304 stainless steel cold-rolled coil used in the manufacture of deep drawn stainless steel sinks did not reflect competitive market costs under regulation 43(2) of the *Customs (International Obligations) Regulation 2015*;
- iii. the use of the benchmark of grade 304 stainless steel cold-rolled coil based on S&P Global Platts North American and European prices in the construction of the normal value under subsection 269TAC(2)(c); and
- iv. the calculation of the profit under regulation 45(2) of the *Customs (International Obligations) Regulation 2015* is erroneous due to insufficient consideration of the commercial likeness of the other goods of the exporter.

The goods to which the application relates are:

Deep drawn stainless steel sinks with a single deep drawn bowl having a volume of between 7 and 70 litres (inclusive), or multiple drawn bowls having a combined volume of between 12 and 70 litres (inclusive), with or without integrated drain boards, whether finished or unfinished, regardless of type of finish, gauge, or grade of stainless steel and whether or not including accessories.

The ADRP proposes to conduct a review of the reviewable decision. Interested parties may make submissions to the ADRP within **30 days** from the date of publication of this notice.
