Hot Rolled Plate Steel Exported from the People's Republic of China

The Anti-Dumping Review Panel (ADRP) has completed a review of a decision by the Minister for Industry (The Minister) to impose countervailing duties with respect to hot rolled plate steel exported from the People's Republic of China. The Minister's decision was published in the Australian on 19 December 2013.

The application for review was made by BlueScope Steel Ltd (Bluescope). A copy of the application and the ADRP Report provided to me is available on the ADRP website <u>www.adreviewpanel.gov.au</u>.

The ADRP has recommended that I affirm the reviewable decision.
