All seeking review of a decision of the Parliamentary Secretary to the Minister for Industry to Publish a Dumping Duty Notice in relation to Power Transformers exported from the Republic of Indonesia, Taiwan, The Kingdom of Thailand and the Socialist Republic of Vietnam (the Reviewable Decision).

The Reviewable Decision was published on **10 December 2014**.

4. If it seems appropriate, any additional background information in relation to the matter, including referring to any relevant policy position or guidelines which impacted on the decision under review.

Please note that the invitation and the response will be placed on the public file. To that end, the Commission is requested to supply a confidential and non-confidential copy of the comments.
