Wind towers exported from China and Korea

Thank you for your letter dated 25 June 2014 concerning the time by which you will provide comments as I requested in my letter of 4 June 2014. As I am sure you appreciate, the Panel (as do you) and interested parties have to work within statutorily mandated time limits. Also, the Panel (again as do you) has to ensure that it affords procedural fairness to those potentially affected by the Panel's decision or recommendations. Friday next week, 4 July, is the last day on which interested parties can provide submissions in the review. If you provide your comments on Monday, 30 June 2014 then, effectively, interested parties (and in particular the applicants) will only have four working days to respond to those comments.

In these circumstances, it is highly desirable that your comments be provided to me no later than 4.00pm tomorrow, Friday 27 June 2014. If this deadline can be met, I will advise the applicants (who at the moment are the only known interested persons participating in the review) that they will receive your comments by the close of business on Friday which I will arrange to be sent directly to them (in addition to publishing those comments on the Public Record).
