**Review Application – Aluminium Road Wheels from the People’s Republic of China**

I write in relation to your application on behalf of Pilotdoer Wheels Co., Ltd (Pilotdoer) for review of a decision by the Anti-Dumping Review Panel (ADRP) under s.269ZZE(1) of the *Customs Act 1901* (Customs Act) dated 18 November 2015 in relation to Aluminium Road Wheels from the People’s Republic of China (the Application).

Ms Joan Fitzhenry, Acting Senior Member of the Review Panel has, pursuant to section 269ZYA of the Customs Act, specified in a written direction that the Review Panel for this review be constituted by me.

The Review Panel wishes to advise that the Application does not comply with s.269ZZE of the Customs Act in the following respects:

1. There is no authorisation by Pilotdoer for Paul Chao of Yinke Law Firm to act on behalf the company;
2. There is no copy of the reviewable decision; and
3. There is no statement identifying what the applicant considers the correct or preferable decision should be.

Pursuant to s.269ZZG(4) of the Customs Act, the Review Panel is able to seek further information from the applicant within the 30-day time period referred to in s.269ZZD of the Customs Act (that is, by 23 November 2015). Pilotdoer may therefore submit the information identified above by 23 November 2015, in order to complete the application.

If at the end of the 30-day period referred to in section 269ZZD, the Review Panel is not satisfied that the Application has satisfied the requirements of s.269ZZE of the Customs Act, it may be rejected under s.269ZZG(2) of the Customs Act.
