**Certain Aluminium Extrusions Exported to Australia from Malaysia and  
the Socialist Republic of Vietnam**

The reinvestigation report in relation to aluminium extrusions is currently due to the Anti-Dumping Review Panel (ADRP) by Sunday, 21 January 2018. As you are aware, I was provided with a timeframe of 60 days to conduct a reinvestigation of certain findings and report to the ADRP as required.

I request an extension of 15 days to Monday, 5 February 2018, to provide this report to the ADRP. I request this extension on the following grounds:

- The Commission's workload to date has meant that the reinvestigation case manager has been unable to undertake the reinvestigation until early to mid January 2018.
- A number of workdays were lost in December 2017 and January 2018 due to the Commission's office shutdown during that period.
