**GRINDING BALLS exported from the PEOPLE'S REPUBLIC OF CHINA**

**Applicants:**

- **Changshe Longte Grinding Ball Co., Ltd;**
- **Jiangsu CP Xingcheng Special Steel Co., Ltd (“Xingcheng”);**
- **Anhui Sanfang New Material Technology Co., Ltd; and**
- **Commonwealth Steel Company Pty Ltd, trading as Moly-Cop Mining Consumables – Waratah Steel Mill.**

The Anti-Dumping Review Panel (ADRP) review of Grinding Balls exported from the People’s Republic of China was initiated on 28 October 2016. A copy of the public notice is attached.

1. The application;
2. Any submissions made by the applicants;
3. The Statement of Essential Facts (SEF) including any attachments or annexures relevant to the grounds of the review application;
4. Any submissions made by any party to the investigation to the ADC commenting on the SEF;
5. Any confidential attachments to the Final Report;
6. Any other *relevant information* (as defined in s269ZZK *Customs Act 1901*) pertinent to the grounds of review raised by the Applicant;

7. Documents containing information relied upon by the ADC in finding that there was a “market situation”; and
8. Correspondence and other records of dealings between the ADC and Xingcheng touching upon sales to related parties, to the extent that those documents have not been included in Xingcheng’s application

**Confidential and Public Documents**

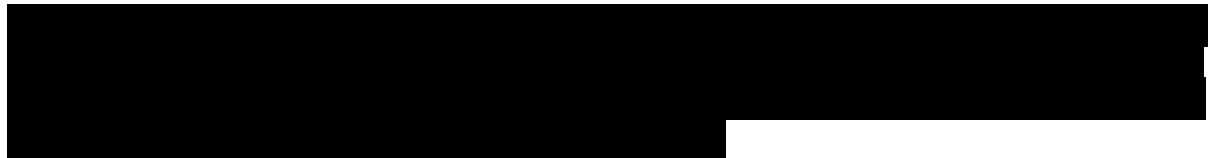
