HOT ROLLED STRUCTURAL STEEL SECTIONS EXPORTED FROM JAPAN, THE REPUBLIC OF KOREA, TAIWAN AND THE KINGDOM OF THAILAND – SUBMISSION DATED 11 MARCH 2015

The ADRP Secretariat forwarded to me your submission dated 11 March 2015 (the 11 March Submission) in response to the ADC's Response to the Panel's Invitation to Comment Letter, dated 23 February 2015 (the ADC Response). As you acknowledged in your covering email, this was outside of the time frame that the Panel would normally consider submissions.

The 'time frame' for lodging submissions is 30 days and is referred to in s269ZZI(2)(c) and s269ZZJ of the Customs Act and s269ZZK(4) prohibits the Panel from considering submissions received after the 30 day period.

I am aware that the ADC's response was received on the last day of the 30 day statutory time period referred to above.

I have noted that the 11 March Submission deals only with the question of the Panel's jurisdiction or power to review a decision relating to the ad valorem form of the anti-dumping duties and does not deal with the merits of the reviewable decision. The Panel is therefore not treating the 11 March Submission as one made under s269ZZJ nor one to which the prohibition in s269ZZK(4) applies. Accordingly, the time limits in ss269ZZJ and 269ZZK(4) do not apply to the 11 March Submission and the Panel has decided to accept it and take it into consideration.
