QUENCHED AND TEMPERED STEEL PLATE Exported from FINLAND, JAPAN AND SWEDEN

The Anti-Dumping Review Panel (ADRP) has completed a review of a decision of the former Parliamentary Secretary to the Minister for Industry and Science (the former Parliamentary Secretary) to impose dumping duties with respect to QUENCHED AND TEMPERED STEEL PLATE exported from FINLAND, JAPAN and SWEDEN. The former Parliamentary Secretary's decision was published in the Australian on 5 November, 2014.

Applications for review were made by BISALLOY STEEL GROUP LIMITED, NIPPON STEEL AND SUMITOMO METAL CORPORATION, JFE STEEL CORPORATION, KOBE STEEL LTD AND TOTAL STEEL OF AUSTRALIA PTY LTD. A copy of the applications and the ADRP's report to me is available on the ADRP website www.adreviewpanel.gov.au.

The ADRP has recommended that I affirm the reviewable decision.

I, KAREN ANDREWS, Parliamentary Secretary to the Minister for Industry and Science, have considered the recommendations and reasons for the recommendations made by the member of the ADRP, including all material findings of fact or law as set out in the ADRP report. In accordance with section 269ZZM (1) of the Customs Act 1901 I affirm the reviewable decision.

Interested parties may seek a review of this decision by lodging an application with the Federal Court of Australia, in accordance with the requirements in the Administrative Decisions (Judicial Review) Act 1977, within 28 days of the publication of this notice.
