## NEWSPRINT Exported to Australia from France

The Anti-Dumping Review Panel (ADRP) has completed a review of my previous decision whilst in the role of the Parliamentary Secretary to the Minister for Industry and Science, to declare by public notice that section 8 of the *Customs Tariff (Anti-Dumping) Act 1975* applies in respect to Newsprint exported to Australia from France (the Reviewable Decision). The Reviewable Decision was publically notified in the Australian newspaper on 30 April 2015. An application for review of the Reviewable Decision was made by UPM Kymmene Pty Ltd (Application). A copy of the Application is published on the ADRP website.

I, KAREN ANDREWS, Assistant Minister for Science and Parliamentary Secretary to the Minister for Industry, Innovation and Science, have considered the recommendations and reasons for the recommendations made by the reviewing member of the ADRP, including all material findings of fact or law as set out in the ADRP report 27 dated 27 November 2015. I have decided to accept the recommendation made in ADRP report 27. In making my decision I have adopted the reasons set out in the ADRP report 27. The ADRP report 27 will be available on the ADRP website on the same day as this notice of decision is published.

In accordance with section 269ZZM of the *Customs Act 1901* I have decided to revoke the Reviewable Decision with effect from 30 April 2015 and substitute a decision not to declare that section 8 of the of the *Customs Tariff (Anti-Dumping) Act 1975* applies in respect of Newsprint exported to Australia from France.
