## ZINC COATED (GALVANISED) STEEL Exported from the People's Republic of China, the Republic of Korea and Taiwan

The Anti-Dumping Review Panel (ADRP) has completed a review of a decision by the then Attorney-General to impose dumping duties with respect to zinc coated (galvanised) steel exported from the Republic of Korea and Taiwan. The then Attorney-General's decision was published in the Australian on 5 August 2013.

Applications for review were made by POSCO and OneSteel Australian Tube Mills Pty Ltd. A copy of the applications and the ADRP Reports to me are available on the ADRP website <a href="https://www.adreviewpanel.gov.au">www.adreviewpanel.gov.au</a>

The ADRP recommended that I affirm the reviewable decision.

I, BOB BALDWIN, Parliamentary Secretary to the Minister for Industry, have considered, and accepted, the recommendations of the ADRP, and the reasons for the recommendations, including all material findings of fact or law as set out in the ADRP Reports. Therefore I AFFIRM the reviewable decision under subsection 269ZZM (1) of the *Customs Act 1901*.

Interested parties may seek judicial review of this decision by lodging an application with the Federal Court of Australia, in accordance with the requirements in the *Administrative Decisions* (*Judicial Review*) *Act 1977*, within 28 days of the publication of this notice.
