**POWER TRANSFORMERS Exported from THE REPUBLIC OF INDONESIA, TAIWAN,
THE KINGDOM OF THAILAND AND THE SOCIALIST REPUBLIC OF VIETNAM**

NOTICE OF REINVESTIGATION OF CERTAIN FINDINGS

The Anti-Dumping Review Panel (ADRP) received applications from CG POWER SYSTEMS INDONESIA, FORTUNE ELECTRIC CO. LTD, ABB LTD (THAILAND), ABB LTD (VIETNAM) and SHIHLIN ELECTRIC (SEEC) for a review of a decision by the then Parliamentary Secretary to publish a dumping duty notice in respect of POWER TRANSFORMERS imported from THE REPUBLIC OF INDONESIA, TAIWAN, THE KINGDOM OF THAILAND and THE SOCIALIST REPUBLIC OF VIETNAM.

The ADRP published a notice on 30 January 2015 that it intended to conduct a review in relation to the then Parliamentary Secretary's decision of 10 December 2014.

On 19 March 2015, I wrote to the Commissioner of the Anti-Dumping Commission requiring him to reinvestigate certain findings in his report to the Minister (REP219). I have asked the Commissioner to report the findings of his reinvestigation by **18 May 2015**.

The ADRP will now be required to provide its report and recommendations for the review to the Parliamentary Secretary **within 30 days after receiving the Commissioner's reinvestigation report**.
